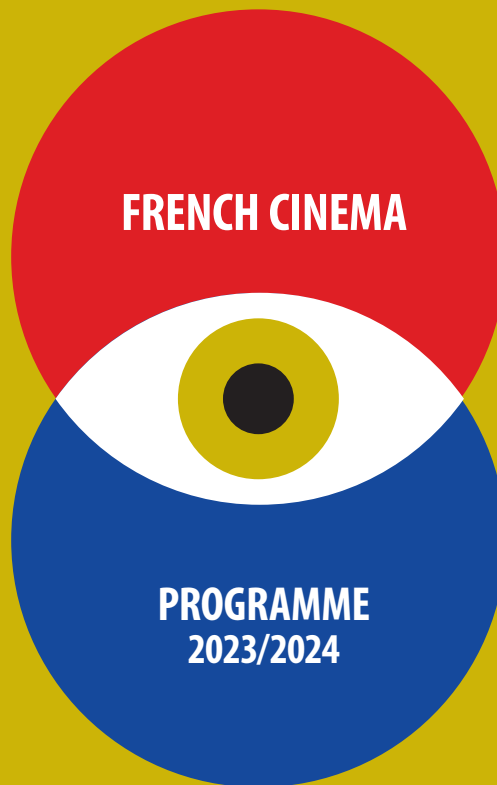

(Boudu Saved from Drowning)

Jean Renoir | France, 1932 | 84 min | 

Comedy. "One of Jean Renoir's most enjoyable films. Its wit, freshness and spontaneity continue to impress. It stars Michel Simon as the anarchic tramp Boudu, who's rescued from drowning by a kindly Parisian bookseller and then installed in the latter's household with chaotic results." (BBC)

(Eyes Without A Face)

Georges Franju | France, 1960 | 88 min | 

Fantasy. Horror. A surgeon causes an accident which leaves his daughter disfigured and goes to extreme lengths to give her a new face. The film's "dreamlike texture" combines "classic film noir aesthetics with a haunting fairytale-like lyricism that is quintessentially French." (FrenchFilms.org)

(Portrait of a Lady on Fire)

Céline Sciamma | France, 2019 | 122 min | 

Period Drama. On an isolated island in Brittany at the end of the eighteenth century, a female artist is commissioned to paint a wedding portrait of a young woman. "Céline Sciamma's glorious period romance is a masterclass of swelling passions in a time of stifling restraint." (Time Out)

Jacques Tati | France, 1949 | 84 min | 

Comedy. In his debut feature, Jacques Tati stars as an ambitious postman living in a small French village. During a local fair, he watches a short film about the American postal system which inspires him to work twice as fast in order to maximise his efficiency.

Jacques Becker | France, 1954 | 83 min | 

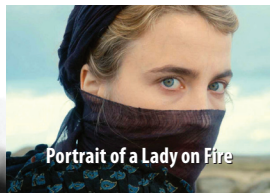
